

SECRET BALLOT ELECTION AND TOWN MEETING WARRANT
THURSDAY JULY, 9TH, 2026

To Gina Batchelder, a resident of the Town of Passadumkeag, in the County of Penobscot, State of Maine,

GREETING:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Passadumkeag in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Community Building in Passadumkeag on Thursday, the 9th day of July 2026 A.D. at Six Thirty PM, then and there to act upon Article 1 and by secret ballot on Article 2 as set out below, the polling hours therefore to be from two o'clock in the afternoon until six o'clock in the afternoon;

And, to notify and warn said inhabitants to meet at the Community Building in Passadumkeag on Thursday, the 9th day of July, 2026 A.D. at six thirty PM, then and there to act on Articles 3 through 6 as set out below, to wit:

Article 1. To elect a moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.

Article 2. To elect all municipal officers and school committee members as are required to be elected.

Article 3. To see if the Town shall vote to authorize the Select Board to enter into a three-year contract, spanning from 2026 to 2029, with LD Excavation for the purpose of winter roads maintenance, including snow plowing, sanding, and salting of town ways, under such terms and conditions as the Select Board deems to be in the best interest of the Town, and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$71410 for the first year of said contract. Recommendation: The Select Board recommends passage.

Article 4. To see if the Town shall vote to authorize the municipal officers to use \$6500 from the town surplus to cover winter road maintenance inflation increases.

Article 5 To see if the town shall vote to authorize the municipal officers to use \$1500 from

registrations.

Article 6 To see if the town will authorize the municipal officers to use \$2000 from surplus to
